

Nurse Residency Program FAQ Sheet

Who is eligible for the Nurse Residency Program?

The Nurse Residency is for graduate nurses who have graduated from an accredited nursing program. Nurse residents must have graduated with a BSN or MSN.

What if I haven't taken the NCLEX or do not yet have my results? Can I still be hired into the Nurse Residency Program?

Nurse residents are required to be licensed prior to their start date.

How long is the Nurse Residency Program?

The Nurse Residency Program lasts for one year. We ask that you commit to employment at Huntington Hospital for one additional year after completing the program.

How many residents will be hired?

The number of residents hired for each cohort is determined in collaboration with the leaders of those clinical areas and is based on the number of staff vacancies.

How often do you offer the Nurse Residency Program?

The Nurse Residency Program has varying start dates each year, usually February or March and August or September. Start dates may vary based on organizational needs.
