POLICY:

Huntington Hospital and Collaborators are committed to the following goals:

- Providing high quality hip and knee replacements for each patient
 - Enhancing efficiencies in delivering lower extremity joint replacement services at Huntington Hospital
 - Promoting quality, efficiency and coordination of services throughout the entire episode of care
1. Huntington Hospital has a CJR steering committee that makes final decisions on individuals/entities to be CJR collaborators.
 2. The Hospital defines Collaborator qualification.
 - (a) Hold an unrestricted license to practice medicine in the State of California, and all customary narcotics and controlled substances numbers and licenses as required by federal, state and local laws and regulations with respect to the Specialty;
 - (b) Maintain in good standing active medical staff appointment, together with the appropriate clinical privileges to provide the Covered Services at Hospital; abide by and comply in all material respects with all bylaws, rules and regulations of the medical staff of Hospital and policies governing the medical staff of Hospital;
 - (c) Be board certified or board eligible in orthopedic surgery;
 - (d) Have never been (i) excluded, debarred, suspended, or otherwise ineligible to participate in state or Federal healthcare programs or in Federal procurement or non-procurement programs or (ii) convicted of a criminal offense that falls within the ambit of 42 U.S.C §1320a-7(a);
 - (e) Have never been convicted of a felony;
 - (f) Be willing to actively participate in Hospital's Care Redesign plan; and
 - (g) Maintain compliance with all Medicare provider enrollment requirements at 42 CFR Section 424.500.
 3. Collaborator shall be an independent contractor of Hospital.
 4. Collaborator shall abide by, comply with and perform all services in accordance with.
 - (a) Hospital's policies, procedures, bylaws, rules and regulations established from time to time;
 - (b) Hospital's compliance program;
 - (c) All applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances and regulations.
 5. Collaborator participates in Care Redesign Plan- design and implementation of processes to improve the delivery of care for CJR Beneficiaries that is mutually developed by Hospital and its Collaborators.

6. Collaborator participates in Quality Performance Metrics achievement which are quality standards mutually agreed upon with Hospital and represent a benchmark for care provided to CJR Beneficiaries. Quality standards have a threshold for quality care provided to Collaborator's CJR Beneficiaries.
