## Access to healthcare services.

### On our campus.



**77,902** visits were made to our Emergency & Trauma Center.

**3,450** visits were made to our Huntington Ambulatory Care Center (HACC) for low- or no-cost primary and specialty care.

**3,392** patients received free nurse navigation services, which support patients throughout their healthcare journey.



### Beyond our walls.

**2,230** community members received complimentary flu shots.

**1,511** people received free health screenings and counseling.

**6** medical clinics “popped-up” at local schools, food pantries and community centers, in partnership with HACC and medical residents.



## Health education and training programs.



**3,143** hospital staff trained in Trauma-Informed Care.

**2,049** people learned how to “Stop the Bleed”.



**219** new parents learned Infant CPR, plus over 100 community members learned Hands-Only CPR.

**1,794** people attended free health education classes.

## Support for older adults.

**3,489** callers benefited from Huntington Senior Care Network Resource Center support and referrals.

**6,847** older adults participated in 50+ HealthConnection membership of Huntington Senior Care Network.
